



2020 Scholarship Application

The Cherry Point Spouse Club will award scholarships to qualified applicants in the spring of 2020. Scholarships of Merit will be awarded based on scholastic achievements, community involvement and a written essay. All awarded scholarships must be used in the following school year of 2020/2021 and are awarded for tuition, fees, books, supplies, and equipment only. Scholarships may not be used to cover room/board expenses nor used for renewing fees for current licensing.

If awarded, the scholarship monies will be sent to the designated University/College after the Scholarship Chairperson has received proof of enrollment no later than 31 May 2020, or the scholarship will be forfeited. Proof of enrollment letters can be obtained from the institution's Registrar.

ELIGIBILITY:

Applicants must be Dependents of Active Duty, Reserve, or Retired Military members assigned to MCAS Cherry Point, defined as:

- Children/Stepchildren (under the age of 23)
- Dependent of deceased military members (residing in the area served by MCAS Cherry Point)
- Must have a high school/college GPA of 2.75 or higher

STUDENTS DEEMED INELIGIBLE FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP:

- Have been awarded a full scholarship
- Have been appointed to any Military Service Academy or awarded a full ROTC scholarship
- Have received a scholarship from another area Officers' Spouses' Club/Military Spouses

*Failure to follow the **Rules** of the Essay format may result in a disqualification from scholarship consideration.*

Essay Rules:

- 1. Type the essay prompt at the top of your essay
- 2. To ensure anonymity, do not include your name anywhere in your essay, just attached it separately with your application in the email.
- 3. To further ensure anonymity, avoid using specific identifying information such as, "My dad was deployed flying with VMA-231 last summer."
- 4. FONT: Calibri 12-point
- 5. Double Spaced
- 6. Length: minimum of 400 words, not to exceed 600 words. (Include a word count with the essay. Exceeding or not meeting word count could be a disqualifying factor).
- 7. Essay must answer **one** of the following two prompts. See next page.

ESSAY PROMPT FOR GRADUATING SENIORS ONLY:

It has been said that *strength of character* is as important as academic success. Take this opportunity to really examine and share with us an experience that taught you something you didn't previously know about yourself, got you out of your comfort zone, or forced you to grow. How will the skills and traits you developed in that experience benefit not only you, but others in the years ahead?

ESSAY PROMPT FOR CONTINUING EDUCATION APPLICANTS ONLY:

What are the most important issues your field of study is facing today? How will your passion, research and education in this field contribute to and make a difference in society?

Include two (2) Letters of Recommendation. All Recommendation Letters must include a completed cover letter to be considered (see page 8 of this document).

- Students who were homeschooled must submit formal documentation of academic achievement or GED.

To verify your sponsor’s assignment to MCAS Cherry Point, please submit a copy of your sponsor’s official orders with the Social Security number redacted or a copy of page 4 of the DD214 if retired locally. These documents will be immediately shredded upon verification of sponsor status.
